## Deadlines for Betsy Kiddy International Study Fund- Faculty-Led Scholarship Applications

In order to apply for this scholarship, students will complete the standard Albright College study abroad application, the <u>Statement of Purpose</u> essay and include one letter of recommendation from an Albright faculty member along with this scholarship application. All materials should be returned to the Experiential Learning and Career Development Center by the deadline.

- Study Abroad experience ideally will be at least one semester long and can be up to full year, but shorter durations will be considered based on their academic merit.
- Location of study must be in South America with priority given to students studying in Brazil and Chile.
- Must include an intensive language instruction program, as approved by the faculty advisor.
- Must include sufficient coursework or research-based program to ensure a high quality, academically rigorous study abroad experience.
- Funds can be used to defray costs of program travel, tuition and fees, and living expenses while abroad.

The Fund will be administered by the College. The Fund will provide individual awards to support qualified Albright students who wish to take part in a study abroad program as approved by the College. The College will publicize the availability of the Fund, select recipients and disburse the awards based the following criteria:

- 1) Two semester language pre-requisite for student candidates
- 2) Selected study program is located in South America and approved by Director of Experiential Learning
- 3) Required letter of recommendation from a faculty member, preferably a language professor
- 4) Required <u>Statement of Purpose</u> essay which addresses: the student's aspirations and goals for the experience, how the study abroad opportunity supports a liberal arts education, and how it relates to the student's chosen course of study and/or professional goals
