The Marian Frances Wolbers Study Abroad Scholarship was established in 2017 in celebration of the lifelong friendship between Michael Walker and Marian Wolbers. Their friendship originated during their time studying abroad at Keio University in Tokyo, Japan.

Deadlines for Marian Wolbers Study Abroad Scholarship- Faculty-Led Scholarship Applications:

Interim 2018	October 6, 2017
Spring 2018	October 6, 2017
Summer 2018 Study	March 2, 2018
Fall 2018	March 2, 2018

In order to apply for this scholarship, students will complete the standard Albright College Study Abroad application, the <u>Statement of Purpose</u> essay and include <u>one letter of recommendation</u> from an Albright faculty member along with this scholarship application. All materials should be returned to the Experiential Learning and Career Development Center by the deadline.

Criteria:

- Student must have financial need.
- Study Abroad experience ideally will be at least one semester long and can be up to full year, but shorter durations will be considered based on their academic merit.
- This scholarship is open to all Albright students with financial need and is awarded with preference given to students studying in Japan or other East Asian countries.
- The study abroad program or exchange must be approved by the director of Experiential Learning.
- Funds can be used to defray costs of program travel, tuition and fees, and living expenses while abroad.
